Applications for Municipal Housing

(市営住宅入居者募集)

From May 20th to June 2nd, 205 units of empty municipal housing will be open to people to apply for. In order to qualify for city housing you must be: a resident in Kawasaki, have being worked in Kawasaki for more than one year, your income does not exceed a normal income, you are facing housing difficulties etc. The types of housing units available are standard family units, small family units, single person units, units aimed at the elderly, extended family units and other kinds of units.

Application forms can be found at Administration (Gyosei) Service Centers, Ward Offices, Branch Ward Offices, and at the Kawasaki Municipal Housing Supply Public Corporation.

Upon filling in the application form and double check all the details such as the dates and type of housing you wish to apply for then post your application to the Kawasaki Municipal Housing Supply Public Corporation. The Opening of the Rose Garden

At the Ikuta Ryokuchi Rose Garden visitors can enjoy viewing and smelling 4,700 roses of 533 varieties that are in bloom at the same time. The Rose Garden will be open until Sunday June 6th.

The Rose Gardens opens from 10:00am on weekdays and from 9:00am on Saturdays and Sundays, it closes at 4:30pm last entry being at 4:00pm. It is free to enter the Rose Garden. To get to the Rose Garden it is a 12 minutes walk from the Odakyu lines Mukogaoka-yuen Station and a 15 minutes walk from the JR Nambu Line Shukugawara Station. Pets are not allowed to enter.
