路上喫煙の防止に関する条例について

A city-wide regulation against smoking on the street went into effect in April of this year. In order to protect pedestrians from being burned by other people's cigarettes, this ordinance bans smoking on the street anywhere in the City of Kawasaki.

The areas around Kawasaki Station, Musashi-Kosugi Station, Musashi-Mizonokuchi Station, Saginuma Station and Shin-Yurigaoka Station have been designated as priority areas for enforcement. In these priority areas, anybody found smoking outside of designated smoking areas will be liable for a fine starting in October. A person found smoking on the street may be given a warning, given directions to the nearest smoking area or ushered to the smoking area. If the person ignores this guidance and continues smoking, that person may be given a nonpenal fine of 2000 yen.

Counseling on all days is from 10 to 12 am and from 1 to 4 pm.



out the garbage collectors' work load through the week and make for a more

efficient garbage collection system. In addition, the way to separate your trash is going to change: envelopes, cake boxes, and similar office paper or light cardboard will go into a new 'mixed paper' category and be collected separately from ordinary trash. Furthermore, the number of garbage collection trucks will be reduced by about 20 percent.

These changes are part of an effort to reduce the number of garbage incinerators used and decrease the amount of rubbish disposed of in landfills by the City of Kawasaki. Your cooperation in making these changes is appreciated.

There will be leaflets distributed to every house in Kawasaki City explaining the new schedule and new rules, and presentations will be made at community meetings across the city. And you'll be able to find information on the new system on Kawasaki City's own home page.
