## New Shuttle Bus from Musashi-kosugi Station to Ida Hospital



A new courtesy bus is now running on a trial basis between Musashi-kosugi Station and Ida Hospital. This direct-service shuttle bus circulates between the main entrance of the hospital and the bus rotary in front of the station. A one-way trip takes about 20 minutes, and there's no charge to ride it.

This trial service will last until November 30<sup>th</sup>, at which time its usefulness to hospital patients and visitors will be evaluated.

The service runs Monday through Friday from 7 a.m. to 6 p.m. Details of the shuttle bus schedule are available on the City of Kawasaki's website.
