Asian Healing 2007 Concert

This spring Musa Kawasaki Symphony Hall is going to host a concert featuring musicians from three East Asian countries.

It's the "Kawasaki, City of Music, Asian Musical Exchange Festival: Asian Healing 2007". Called in Japanese the ONGAKU NO MACHI – KAWASAKI, AJIA KOURYU ONGAKUSAI 'ASIAN HEALING 2007', it's happening on Saturday the 17th of March. It's part of a project to commemorate the Japan-Korea Friendship Year 2005; since the first concert was held in March of '05, this will be the third year it is held.

Performers from Japan will include Aragaki Tsutomu, Sakamoto Miu with Ohata Yuuichi, and Atari Kosuke. Son Min from Korea will also be there, as will Amin from China and others. Under the theme of "Asian Healing" these performers from the forefront of music in their respective countries will make gorgeous music that transcends genres.

Advance tickets are now on sale. They're 5800 yen for S- type seats, 4800 yen for A – seats, and 3800 yen for B – seats. You can get them by calling Kyodo Yokohama at 0.45 - 6.71 - 9.911.

Kawasaki in Contemporary Art

Kawasaki City Museum is hosting an exhibition of works by four winners of the Made in Kawasaki Contemporary Art Award.

The English title of the exhibition is "Individuals: Noritoshi Motoda, Kazuko Kizawa, Michiko Sahara, Nao Sugaya: Made in Kawasaki." In Japanese it's called "INDIVIDUALS : KOSA SURU YO-NIN 'MADE IN KAWASAKI' GENDAI BIJUTSU-SHO JUSHO-SHA TEN"

The Kawasaki City Museum held an art contest a while back in which they called for modern artworks which addressed the theme of "Kawasaki". In response, artists from all over the country sent in a total of a hundred and sixteen different works.

One of these pieces was voted the Grand Prize, and another three were awarded Judge's Prizes. The current exhibition presents work by the four prize winners. With their impressive creations the four artists show us their different ways of seeing the world.

The exhibition will continue until Sunday February the 25th. To get to the Kawasaki City Museum, take a bus from Musashi-kosugi Station and get off at the "SHIMIN MUSEUM MAE" bus stop.
