# Rabies Vaccination: Is your Dog Up-To-Date?

「犬の予防接種」について

Starting in April, Kawasaki City will no longer hold its mass rabies vaccinations in outdoor locations. Instead, participating veterinary hospitals will vaccinate dogs on an individual basis.

From April 1st through May 31st these institutions will offer rabies vaccinations for the same price as was previously charged at the outdoor mass vaccinations.

In addition, throughout the year immediately after you get the injection done they'll be able to issue the tag that proves your pet was inoculated.

The vaccination itself costs about 2,950 yen for one animal, and the fee for the vaccination tag is about 550 yen.

Different animal hospitals may offer vaccinations on different days and times, so be sure to check before you go. To find a participating veterinary hospital near you, please contact the public health section of your ward office.

## Garbage Collection Days Are Changing

This year the municipal garbage collection days are going to change. Beginning in April, ordinary trash will be picked up three times a week and recyclable resources will be picked up once per week.

Some parts of the city will have garbage picked up on Mondays, Wednesdays and Fridays, while other parts will have trash collected on Tuesdays, Thursdays and Saturdays. For example, if an area which now has ordinary trash pickup on Mondays, Tuesdays, Wednesdays and Fridays changes to a Monday-Wednesday-Friday pickup schedule, any trash put out on Tuesday will be picked up on Wednesday along with Wednesday's garbage.
