Certificates Of Alien Registration Are Coming Due

For a little while after the changeover of the system, the old Certificate of Alien Registration was considered to be equivalent to a Residence Card or Special Permanent Resident Certificate. However, people now holding a Certificate of Alien Registration are soon going to have to exchange it for the new card that applies to them under the new system. Below are the deadlines for people to change to the correct documentation:



Mid- to long term residents holding a Certificate of Alien Registration:

Please go to your Regional Immigration Office to change to the new card on the schedule below.

status of residence	age	period the current Certificate of Alien Registration will be considered to be equivalent to a Residence Card
permanent resident	less than 16 years old	until July 8, 2015 (Heisei 27) or your 16 th birthday, whichever comes first
	16 years or older	until July 8 th , 2015 (Heisei 27) ※Whatever the date on your Certificate of Alien Registration, please bring the Certificate you now hold to your Regional Immigration Office by July 8 th , 2015 to change it for a Residence Card.

★If you have a Designated Activities and any other status of residence, the deadline is the same as above.

★If you are a Special Permanent Resident, please take your Certificate of Alien Registration to your town hall/village office to change it for a Special Permanent Resident Certificate.

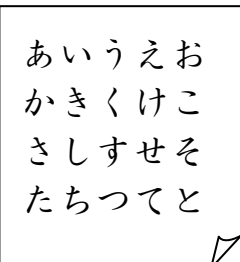
