Information Session for Foreign Residents: How to Apply for Public Housing

Persons who wish to apply for public housing but are unsure how to fill out the form can attend this session to receive guidance on the application process.

(Interpretation is available upon request of the following languages: English, Chinese, Korean,

Portuguese, Spanish, Filipino, Thai, Nepali, and Vietnamese)

When: June 15th (Sat) 10am to 12pm

Where: 2nd floor Activity Room of Kawasaki International Center

Application Period: Apply by phone, e-mail or in person no later than Wednesday, June 7th, 4:30pm.

Public housing is: Projected jointly by the city and the national government (owned by the city) for low-income earners who have housing problems so that they can rent at a reasonable fee. Unlike private real estate, there's an application period, income criteria, and other rules. There is no need for key money or renewal fees, but a tenant's income is checked annually to determine their rental fee.

Application criteria: (1) Legal age

(2) Resident of Kawasaki City for at least a year or have worked at the same job in Kawasaki for at least a year

(3) Monthly income not above a certain level

(4) Having serious problems related to housing etc.
