

!!! A major earthquake has occurred! What do I do now?

If you are indoors...

First, move to protect yourself.



Check the safety of your surroundings.



Put out any small fires around you, if possible.

Move calmly toward the exit.



Help the people around you.

If you are outdoors...

Remain calm and move to protect your head from falling objects.

Move away from anything that seems about to fall.



Evacuate on foot. (Do not use a car, elevator, etc.)
