- Ordinary garbage and recyclable materials will be collected according to the regular schedule until Dec. 30, 2024 (Mon). Regular collection will resume on Jan. 4, 2025 (Sat).
- · Oversized garbage is collected by advance reservation. Make your reservation at least 3 working days in advance. (Excluding Saturdays, Sundays or the 12/31-1/3 holiday period).
