## Information Session for Foreign Residents: How to Apply for Public Housing

Anyone who wishes to apply for public housing but is unsure how to fill out the form is welcome to attend this session to receive guidance on the application process.

Interpretation is available upon request of the following languages: English, Chinese, Portuguese, Spanish, Filipino, Thai, Nepali, and Vietnamese.

**Public housing is:** constructed jointly by the city and the national government (owned by the city) for low-income people with housing problems to rent at reasonable rates. Unlike in the private market, there's an application period, income criteria, and other rules. There is no key money or renewal fee, but a tenant's income is checked annually to determine their rental rate.

**Applicants qualifications:**

- (1) Legal adult
- (2) Resident of Kawasaki City and/or have worked at the same place in Kawasaki for at least a year
- (3) Monthly income meets required amount
- (4) Having serious housing problems

## Where to see cherry blossoms in Kawasaki City



In Kawasaki City, there are many parks and greenery you can enjoy. Here are a few splendid places for cherry blossom viewing. Please check them out by all means.

**Yumemigasaki Zoological Park (Saiwai ward: use JR Shin-Kawasaki or Kashimada Station)** : Cherry trees are planted in various places around the park, including inside the zoo so that you can enjoy the animals along with the cherry blossoms. Around 400 trees in total. Types: Yoshino cherry, *Yamazakura*, and others.

**Sumiyoshi zakura (Naka ward: use Tokyu Toyoko or Meguro lines Motosumiyoshi Station)**: A row of cherry trees blossoming in full glory seems to be pushing out over the river. Gaily-blossoming Yoshino cherry trees line the Shibukawa River for about 2 kilometers. You can also enjoy the cherry blossoms at nearby Nakahara Heiwa Park. Around 250 Yoshino cherry trees in total.

**Nikaryo Yosui Canal (Tama ward: use JR Nambu line Shukugawara Station)**: A historical irrigation channel built in the Edo era. The 2-kilometer path is lined with around 400 cherry trees.

Note: an administrative scrivener can advise on many things, but mainly they help with applications for various permits and licenses, inheritance procedures, visa and status of residence paperwork, incorporating a business, drawing up contracts, writing wills, etc.
