These concerts are free and open to everybody. Please come along on the day and you will have a good time listening to beautiful music.

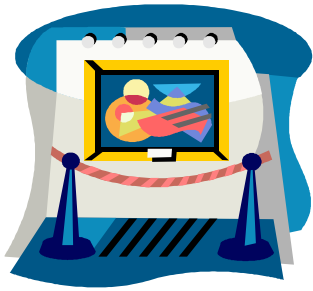
The Lobby Concert

To view the exhibit costs ¥500 for adults, ¥300 for students, and free for people aged over 65 and Junior High School students.

In Unity 2004

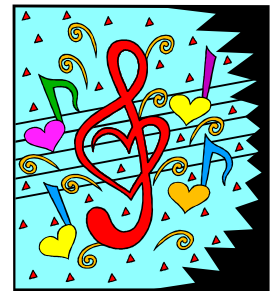
